



1960 356B Super 90 Electric Sunroof

There is no Porsche 356 more rare than this “one of one” car, believed to be the only 356B Super 90 ever built with a “pre-production” version of an electric sunroof.

Designed by sunroof specialist Golde and delivered to Reutter with a complex mechanism of cables, tubing and hoses completed with a 6V electric motor mounted in the engine bay, it is easy to see why Porsche decided to stay with manual sunroofs until the advent of the headliner mounted motor a few years later.

Ordered from noted Porsche dealer Brumos for a special client who was too late to complete a Carrera purchase, this unique 356 was also equipped with a full luggage set, chrome wheels, corduroy seat inserts and a passenger head rest.

Fresh from a multi-year restoration by noted Porsche 356 authority Cole Scrogam and students at Madison Automotive Apprentices in cooperation with metal and body specialists at Carolina Coach Crafters, this Porsche 356 is the crown jewel of the David Cottrell collection from Richmond, VA.

A focus on originality combine with modern 3D printing and fabrication techniques to make the sunroof a fully functioning unit. No expense was spared to return this rarity to original condition, as it was ordered in 1960 in the classic combination of Metallic Silver over Red.
